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Cattle Identification Form — Instructions

The use of either **Cattle Identification Form, (Simple or Expanded version)** is optional and other methods of record keeping are also certainly acceptable. The simple version of the Cattle Identification Form (page 1 of this document) provides a means to correlate back tag and ear tag information when this type of information is recorded. The expanded version of the form (page 2 of this document) allows for the back tag/ear tag information to be recorded, along with pregnancy status, age and breed if this information is more desirable. Generally, it is accepted that records should be maintained a minimum of 5 years.

USERS:

The Cattle Identification Form has been designed as a tool to assist anyone, (owners, veterinarians, markets) in recording and correlating information on any species of livestock, including cattle. Either version of the Cattle Identification Form may be printed blank and the information recorded by hand. Alternately, data may be entered electronically on the form.
