## TAHC Moves Rockdale Region Office to Giddings

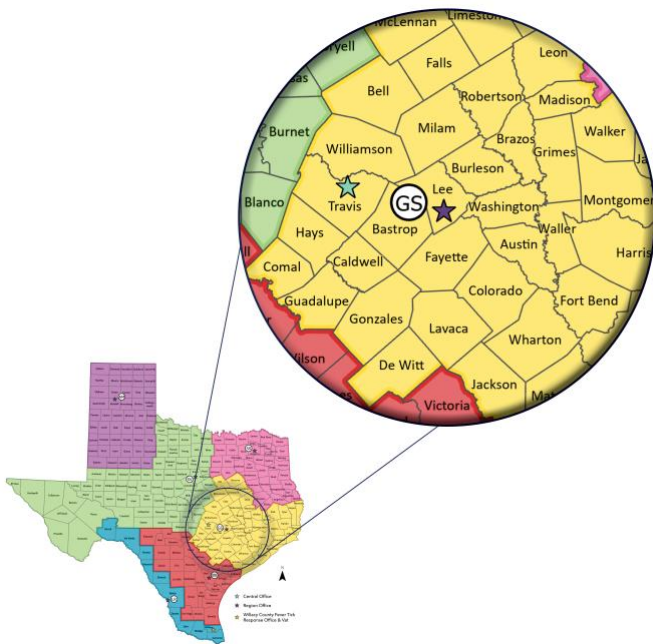
AUSTIN, TX –The Texas Animal Health Commission (TAHC) relocated the Rockdale Region Office to Giddings, TX on January 1, 2023. This move strategically positions TAHC’s regional personnel, while facilitating cost savings, to continue working to protect the health and marketability of Texas livestock, poultry, and exotic livestock and fowl.

The new office is located at 152 Industrial Park Road, Giddings, TX 78942. Current region office staff can be contacted at 512-446-2507. The region is now designated as the Giddings Region and abbreviated GS on maps and other agency documents.

TAHC Agency Veterinarians, Region Managers, Livestock Inspectors and Region Office Support Staff will continue to be available throughout the region for regulatory work.
