## **TAHC Rule Proposal Open for Public Comment**

Chapter 59, General Practices and Procedures

AUSTIN, TX – The Texas Animal Health Commission (TAHC) held a regularly scheduled Commission meeting April 30, 2024, at its headquarters in Austin.

The following amendments were proposed during the meeting and are open for comment from May 31 – June 30, 2024.

## **Chapter 59, General Practices and Procedures**

The proposed amendments add guidance on the responsibilities of TAHC staff when working with local law enforcement authorities to enforce entry requirements. This is proposed to be added to the existing section that sets forth the responsibilities of TAHC staff when partnering with the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) to enforce entry requirements.
