

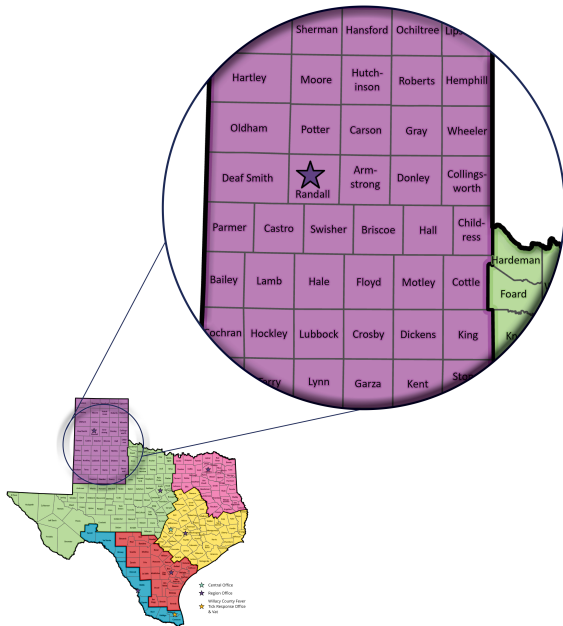

TAHC Relocates Amarillo Region Office to New Address

AUSTIN, TX –The Texas Animal Health Commission (TAHC) relocated the Amarillo region office to Canyon, TX on July 8, 2024. The new office is located at 2510 FM 2590, Canyon, TX 79015, and region office staff can be contacted at the new number 806-641-7000.

This move strategically positions TAHC’s regional personnel to continue working to protect the health and marketability of Texas livestock, poultry, and exotic livestock and fowl. The region continues to be designated as the Amarillo Region, abbreviated as AM on maps and other agency documents.



TAHC region directors, region managers, field veterinarians, livestock inspectors and region administrative staff will continue to be available throughout the region for regulatory work.
