

TITLE 4 AGRICULTURE
PART 2 TEXAS ANIMAL HEALTH COMMISSION
PROPOSED RULE REVIEWS

The Texas Animal Health Commission (Commission) proposes to review and consider for readoption, revision, or repeal the following chapters listed below, in its entirety, contained in Title 4, Part 2, of the Texas Administrative Code:

Chapter 40, Chronic Wasting Disease

Chapter 41, Fever Ticks

Chapter 53, Market Regulation

Chapter 54, Domestic and Exotic Fowl Registration

Chapter 57, Poultry

This review is conducted in accordance with the requirements of Texas Government Code §2001.039, which requires state agencies, every four years, to assess whether the initial reasons for adopting a rule continue to exist. After reviewing its rules, the agency will readopt, readopt with amendments, or repeal its rules.
